

C-Java

Rules and Regulations

- C-Java is primarily used for meal services and receptions. Allowed events include cocktail receptions, wedding receptions, and dinners. **Absolutely no parties allowed.**
- Lessee is not permitted to use any kitchen equipment, utensils or buffet line equipment unless meal services are being provided by C-Java.
- C-Java will accommodate 100 people reception style or 90 people seated for dinner.
- C-Java can be rented from 3 pm until 10 pm **only** Monday – Friday, and Noon until 10 pm Saturday and Sunday. The room must be vacated at 10 pm due to sleeping quarters directly next to the area.
- Catering is available. Please contact Hotel General Manager for details.
- **Absolutely no furniture or accessories will be moved by Lessee.**
- Live music and DJ's are prohibited in the Concourse. Soft CD or cassette music without amplification only.
- Lessee will be responsible for damages and guest behavior. Also, lessee agrees to reimburse repair costs for any damage done by his/her guests.
- Cancellation at least three days prior to meeting date is required to receive refund.
- All public areas in the Criminal Justice center, including the Hotel are tobacco free. This includes C-Java, Bluebonnet Suite, lobby, halls, guest rooms, etc.
- The walk way running through the C-Java from CJ to the Hotel must remain free from obstruction at all times per the University Safety Office. Also, no screens, tables, chairs, and/or miscellaneous items may be stored in the exits or stairwells. All exits and stairwells must remain free and clear at all times.
